Arrival and getting to Malham Tarn field station

By Plane

If you are arriving by plane, the most convenient airports are Leeds-Bradford and Manchester (but it may be worth checking London airports as well as flights are more regular and can be cheaper.

Leeds-Bradford Airport

The Flying Tiger bus service connect Leeds-Bradford airport with Leeds train station. The journey cost is £6, payable in cash only but sterling and euros are accepted. The journey takes 25 minutes. The stop required is City Square and the station is located on the south side of the square. From Leeds station there are hourly trains to Skipton approximately £18 return and several trains each day to Settle, approximately £21 return.

Manchester Airport

From Manchester airport, there are frequent trains to Skipton, journey time 2 hours 30 minutes and approximately £35-£40 return and Settle, journey time 2 hours 45 minutes and approximately £40 return.

By Train

The nearest rail station is Settle and a minibus pick up will be arranged from here. There are two trains to Settle in the afternoon/evening; the main pick up will be arranged for the 15:45 train but if there are a number of people arriving late then a pick up can be arranged for the 19:10 train. If you arrive late or do not want to for a minibus a taxi from Settle will cost approximately £25 but it is essential that this is pre-booked as there are very limited services (good taxi firms to try are; Bosh and Becks +44 (0) 7753226132; Settle Taxis +44 (0) 1729 824824; Stainforth Private Hire +44 (0) 7855824666 There a number of pubs and cafes in Settle town centre, 5 minute walk from the station, simply turn right of the station entrance and walk up the road. Skipton station is further from the field centre but trains are much more frequent, usually hourly from Leeds or Carlisle. A minibus pick up will not be arranged from Skipton station. There is a taxi rank outside Skipton station but some firms are unwilling to make the journey to the field centre. CJ's Taxis can be prebooked on 0808 1451070. 
By car

From Malham (Skipton, Leeds, M1, A1) As you enter Malham Village pass the Buck Inn on your left and stay on this road past Malham Cove and up a long winding hill and along the flat for 3 miles to a crossroads. Go straight ahead past High Trenhouse (Centre for Management Creativity) and down to a T junction. Turn right and drive with the wood on your right hand-side for ½ mile. Ignore the gated track (no vehicular access). Pass through a narrow section of road with wall on either side and then take a sharp right hand turn marked with a small sign to the Field Centre. Follow the track for ¾ mile, though a narrow rock cutting, round the back of the centre buildings into the car park.

From Settle/Hawes (Kendal, Preston, M6) Take the B6479 to Langcliffe (do not follow signs to Malham from Settle town centre) and turn into Langcliffe at the sign 'Malham 7 ½'. Follow the road for 3 miles up a steep winding hill, down to an isolated farm and up another long hill. Bear right at the top of the hill at the sign 'Malham 4 ¼'. After a mile the road forks at a small wood. Bear left at the sign 'Arncliffe 5 ¾' (do not take the road back to Malham). Drive with the wood on your right hand-side for ½ mile. Ignore the gated track (no vehicular access). Pass through a narrow section of road with wall on either side and then take a sharp right hand turn marked with a small sign to the Field Centre. Follow the track for ¾ mile, though a narrow rock cutting, round the back of the centre buildings into the car park

Return

There will be a minibus to take people back to Settle station on the final day of the course at approximately 15:15 to arrive for 15:45 or 18:30 to arrive for 19:00 depending on your travel arrangements.



Accommodation

Accommodation is included on the evening before the course start day but not for the evening of the last day, if you need accommodation for the final day you can contact the field station directly.

Bedding and towels are provided and there will be a buffet and welcome drinks for everyone on the evening of arrival.

Please check current travel information for details of any road works that may interfere with your chosen route. If you are driving and have opted for the all-inclusive option, please aim to be at the field station for late afternoon – to early evening on the day before the course start date, between 17:00 and 18:30 is ideal but you are welcome to arrive anytime, please let us know.
